EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in collaborating with us in our Annual Celebration of the Nisga'a New Year at the Nisga'a Ts'amiks Edition Hoobiyee 2020.

We are of the Nisga'a Nation, a First Nations group from the Nass Valley BC. Our ancestral land is approximately 100km west of Terrace BC. We have over 1,500 Nisga'a members residing here in Vancouver and across Vancouver Island.

Our organization carries a goal to assist and to enhance the social, economic, physical, cultural and spiritual well-being of Nisga'a Citizens and their families. Our Nisga'a Ts'amiks community involves Nisga'a individuals and their families (non-Nisga'a and Nisga'a alike). Residing in an urban setting far from our homelands, Nisga'a Ts'amiks continues to, and invites all, to practice our philosophy:

“Say't K'ilim Goot- One Heart, One Path, One Nation.”

EXHIBITOR/VENDOR TABLE POLICY

1. Applications are subject to approval by the Hoobiyee Ts'amiks Edition- 2020 Committee.
2. Once approved, in order to confirm your table FULL payment is due by payment **November 29, 2019**. Failure to do so could result in the table going to the next person on the wait list.
3. Exhibitors/Vendors will be required to abide by the exhibitor agreement.
4. Rental fees are final and non-negotiable. There will be NO REFUNDS once vendors have paid rental fees for the event.
5. Tables/booths are assigned and exhibitors will **not be permitted to move or alter tables** from their assigned location or the position that they are set up.
6. There are no additional benefits with the role as a vendor; there will be no backstage passes, elder's passes or any other passes, unless notified otherwise by Nisga'a Ts'amiks staff.
7. All Exhibitors/Vendors:
 - a. Are responsible for bringing necessary materials for setting up their table/booth (ie- tape, paper for signage, table covers), no materials will be provided by Nisga'a Ts'amiks Staff or Hoobiyee Committee.
 - b. Exhibitors/Vendors are not permitted to sell any type of food.
 - c. NO Raffle or 50/50 tickets are permitted to be sold by vendors.
8. We encourage Artisan/Small Business Vendors to sell items made locally, or in collaboration with First Nations artists. Imported/in-authentic goods will *not* be accepted to sell.
9. Rules and regulations are subject to change, vendors will be informed of any changes.

10. We gratefully accept any donated items from our vendors for our event to raffle off as a door prize.
11. All Exhibitors/Vendors are responsible for monitoring their table. NTVS or PNE are not responsible for lost or stolen belongings/merchandise.
12. Exhibitors/vendors bringing their own tables, clothing racks etc. **NTVS has the Right to charge Exhibitor/vendor the Booth rate (\$500), as space is limited.**
13. NTVS does have security, however this is to ensure safety of the general public, not to monitor Exhibitor/vendor tables.
14. Exhibitors/vendors Must sign in at the administration table upon arrival.
15. There are outlets along the walls if exhibitors/vendors need, they can request to be placed along the walls.
16. Payment for Exhibitor/Vendor MUST be by Cheque or cash, NTVS does not accept Email transfers or debit payments.

3. All Exhibitors/Vendors:
 - Are not are not permitted to sell any type of food.
 - NO Raffle or 50/50 tickets are permitted to be sold by vendors
4. Artisan/Small Business Vendors please note:
 - Imported/inauthentic goods will not be accepted to sell.
 - No businesses or representatives; Artist must attend
5. I will place no responsibility, liability or blame on the Nisga'a Ts'amiks Vancouver Society, the Nisga'a Ts'amiks Hoobiyee 2020 committee, the City of Vancouver or any employees or volunteers of the Nisga'a Ts'amiks Vancouver Society for any lost, stolen or damaged work, tools, materials, and supplies or any other trade, business and/or personal items.
